Late Prof. H.S. Paul was born in 1934 at Moulara, P.O. Manglapore, Garbeta, Paschim Medinipur. He lost his father at an early age and was brought up by his elder brother Late Manmatha Nath Paul. Because of his constant support and encouragement he excelled in education. He was a gold medalist from Jadavpur University, PhD from IIT, Kharagpur in Mathematics and worked as a professor in IIT, Madras. A number of scholars had earned PhD degree under his supervision and he was a fellow of Acoustical Society of America (ASA). He visited many countries and was a frequent visitor of ASA (USA). He established the AFECT in Chennai in 1998, which was shifted to Taldangra, Fatesingpur, near Garbeta station in 2009. His main interest was to establish a centre for excellence for acoustically challenged children by introducing modern method of learning to help these children to grow into independent and respectful individual. Unfortunately Prof. Paul expired on 1st December, 2012.

As a mark of respect to the deceased the present Trust board is working to fulfill his desire and vision. The Trust is committed in establishing an English medium CBSE school up to standard XII. A special charitable center for acoustically challenged children is also initiated along with other programs to improve their physical and mental health . The trust invites all local people to be associated with AFECT so that it can be a unique Educational Institute for our children. The Institute will provide a platform for next generation to build a better career and eventually become responsible

citizens of the country.





Features:-

Co- educational English medium school with CBSE Curriculum and NEP guidelines.

Health:-

The school will conduct periodical health checks-ups of students and submit report to the parents whenever required. The sick room of the school is well equipped with First Aid equipment and trained staff.

Present Status:-

Anandam is presently running upto class IX. It has already got state level N.O.C. from W.B. Govt and school affiliation from CBSE upto secondary level and will upgrade to high secondary level gradually.

Educational Tour/Excursion:-

To enhance the Educational experience with learning by seeing and have a live experience. Educational Tour / picnic will be conducted for all students along with parents. Date & program will be notified later on. It is compulsory for all students and participate as per CBSE rule.

Security:-

The school will ensure security of students and visitors. Entry into the school campus will be restricted. Visitors may be allowed in an emergency to meet a student and / or the child may be handed over to the escort after necessary verification/notification only. We have CCTV surveillance around the campus.

Faculty:-

Teachers for each class are qualified, trained (Montessori, B.Ed or M.Ed, B.Ped) and well experienced. Continuous appraisal and training of the faculty members are carried out by the Academic Advisors/ Administrators of the school. Methodology of Teaching is based on Activity based learning. Teachers follow their lesson –plan for activity – based teaching- learning through worksheet solving & demonstration, projects, fieldwork etc.

Assessment:-

A student not having the required attendance (80%) will not be promoted to the next class. Parents are requested to track attendance of their wards, as intimated through the school diary or progress report.







Two unit tests, two Formative Assessment, one mid-term and one final exam will be held in every session as a part of Continuous & Comprehensive Evaluation(CCE). Students will get Report cards after each Test/Examination, which are required to be returned to the class Teacher's duly signed by the guardian (except the final exam report card). (Parents may visit on scheduled dates and times to see their ward's answer scripts).

Communication with the school:-

It is mandatory for parents / guardians to acknowledge/reply all the circulars sent by school and maintain regular interaction with the class teacher through the school diary and to attend every parent- teacher meeting.

Parents/guardians have to meet the school authorities as and when called for any failure on their part to comply with the request of the authority will be dealt with as per the prevailing rules and regulations of the school. Management of the school reserves the right to amend the clauses contained in the prospectus. The decision of the Management will be binding to all concerned regarding any matter mentioned or not contained in the prospectus.

Co-curricular and Extracurricular activities:-

The school regularly conducts co-curricular and extracurricular activities like sports & events, like Football, Volleyball, Badminton, Marshal Art Yoga, Art,& Craft, drawing where activities are offered to children according to age- groups of the children. The school has developed its own beautiful modern play ground in the campus. For special development of a childs talent separate special marshal art class is conducted within our school campus after the school hours to be self independent.

- Special drawing class is also conducted at our campus to enhance imaganitive skills and talent.
- Special Football coaching and Yoga class is also conducted to keep the child healthy and active and stay away from mobile addiction.
- Special Tuition / coaching is done by our own school teachers in subjects like English/Hindi/Maths/ Science.
- Spoken English language lab to be started from this academic session onwards to improve communicative skills of students
- Upgradtion of science and Math lab and library.


Days and Timings:-

Medium of Instruction: The medium of instruction is English. Care will be taken so that the students improve fluency and confidence in the language. Interaction in vernacular is not allowed during school hours except during the vernacular classes.

ENGLISH LAB:- Special Coaching classes for Bengali Medium Students to shift in English Medium from class I to Class IX free of cost.

Visiting Hours: Guardians are welcome to meet the Principal/Co - ordinator from 10:00AM to 10:30AM on Monday, Wednesday & Friday.

Field Trip/Study Tour:- School will organize a study-tour programmed once in a year to enrich the student's observation power through nature study. **Computer Education:-** Compulsory computer education with multimedia, games, learning hardware online software and other from std. I to IX.

Special Attraction:- Well connected roads, beautiful garden & Big campus, Sports and game facilities, Vast Library, well ventilated class rooms, general science, Computer and Maths Lab, Girls common room & Sick room, Fire fighting arrangement, safe drinking water facilities, each floor of the building has separate clean toilets for boys & girls. New Modern Building as per CBSE norms for Secondary has been inaugurated on 1st Dec 2019 with CCTV and modern park along with digital class-room.



AFECT runs a special charitable educational center for acoustically challenged (Deaf) children on every Saturday and Sunday from 8AM to 12 noon. The Institute provides speech training by qualified instructor with hearing aids/cochlear machine to needy children of this locality by a qualified trained instructor. This vocational school for deaf is planning special training programs to these children for tailoring, toy making etc, Emphasis will be given on computer education for class V onwards. The institute also aims to organize medical camps from time to time for medical support and regular health awareness program for these children


